

GENERAL ORDER NO. 650

The Court declares its desire to consider the appointment of a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for a period of eight (8) years, contingent upon a vacancy in the office which will be created when Magistrate Judge Ruben B. Brooks retires in August 2016. For that purpose, the attached public notice will be published in the San Diego Union Tribune, a general local newspaper. Notice shall also be published on the Court's website and distributed to the bar through CM/ECF.

In accordance with the requirements of § 420.30 *et seq.* of the Guide to Judiciary Policy's Chapter on the Selection, Appointment, and Reappointment of Magistrate Judges, the Court appoints the following persons to serve on the Merit Selection Panel:
